THE MAXIMUM WEIGHT IN POUNDS FOR EVENTS INDICATED. Weigh-in and registration for all crews and coxswains including Heavyweights will be from 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 3, and 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. on Sunday, June 4, 1978.

Weight – Women Cox's 88 lbs. (40 kilos) Men Cox's 105 lbs. (48 kilos)

HEATS WILL BE ROWED STARTING FRIDAY, 7.30 p.m., JUNE 2, AND SATURDAY A.M., JUNE 3.
Novice class refers to entire crews including coxswain, 1st year in active high school or club rowing as of 1st Sept. of that academic school year. Draw will be held on Sunday, May 28th, 1978.

NOTE–

There will be no change in the order of events and all races will start promptly as scheduled.
All Members of Competing Crews must be of the same sex and wear uniform rowing jerseys.

COMPETITORS WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER TWO EVENTS ONLY, INCLUDING SPARES.

NO COMPOSITE CREWS WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER IN ANY EVENT.
