



## EFFICIENCY TROPHY:

That the following will form the rules and scoring for the Efficiency Trophy for Men's and Women's Championships:

1. To be eligible for the Men's and/or Women's Team Efficiency Trophy and Banner a school must finish in at least four (4) event finals in the men's events;
2. The schools efficiency ranking is based on the average of the top four (4) finish positions in the final events;
3. All boat classes have the same percentage value related to placing in the final event;
4. In the event of a tie for first place the final efficiency score will not change but the school with the higher ranking using the tie breaker system below will be awarded the Championship trophy and Banner.
5. The tie breaker will be the finish position of the fifth crew that qualifies for the finals, then the sixth crew and so on, if a school does not have a 5th crew finish the school that has finished a fifth crew will be the winner.
